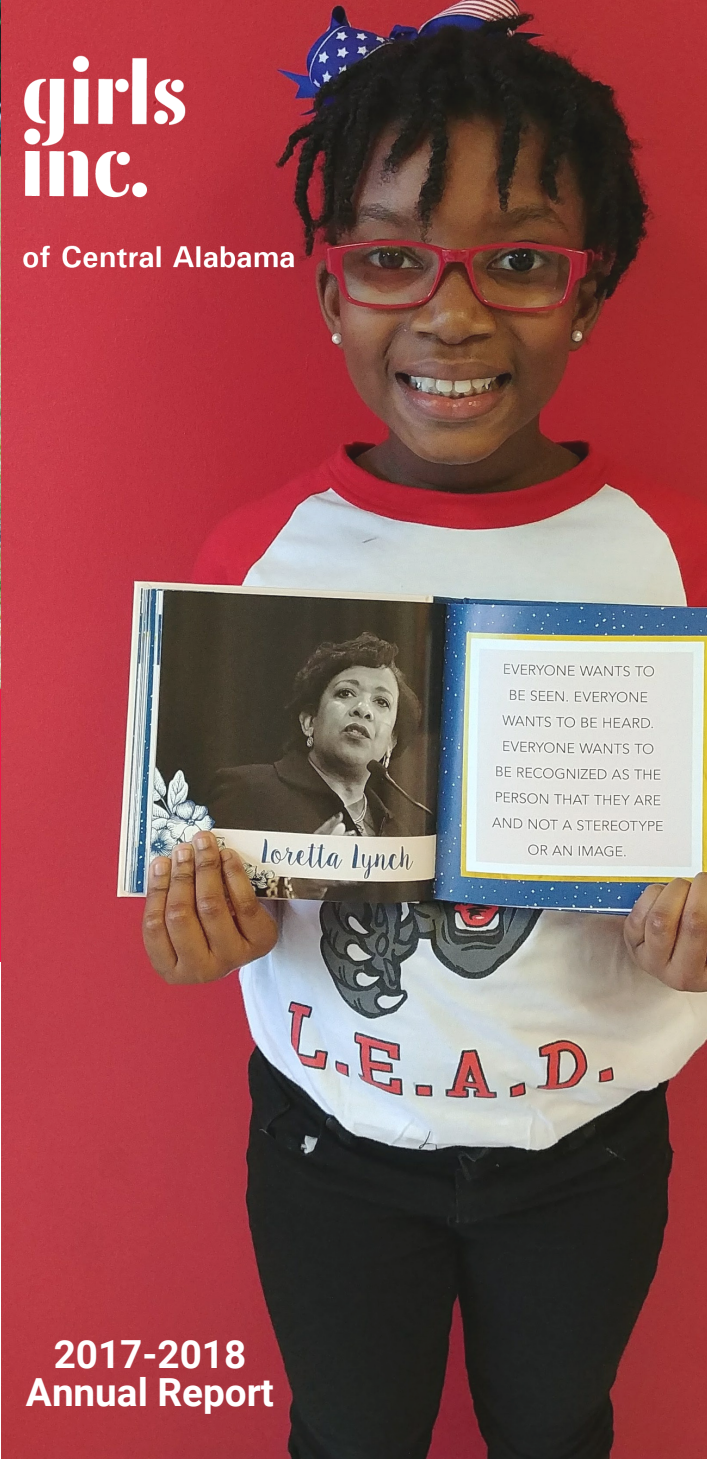

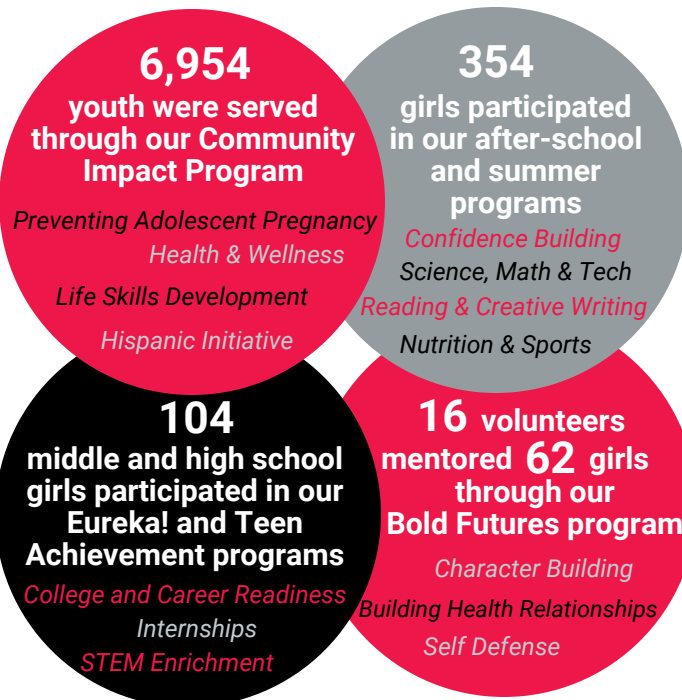

## Measuring the Impact

Girls Inc. of Central Alabama measures girl success each year through the Strong, Smart, and Bold Outcomes Survey. Here are some of the findings from our 2018 survey.

**STRONG** 89% of girls are happy with their bodies, compared to 48% nationally.

**SMART** 93% care about doing well in school.

**BOLD** 100% are hopeful about their future.
