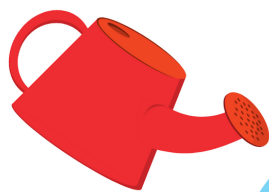

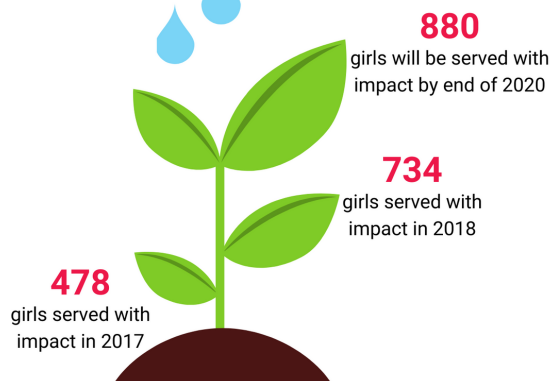

In 2018, Girls Inc. of Central Alabama was awarded seed money from the National organization to double the number of girls it serves with impact (50 hours+ of programming) each year. Funding raised from individuals, foundations, and corporations matches that seed money to aid in this growth.



How we are growing

Girls Inc. of Central Alabama has developed new programs, expanded partnerships with schools and increased enrollment in existing programs to achieve our growth goals. Here are just a few of our achievements:

GIRLS INC CLUBS

Girls Inc. has started offering programming in schools through its new Girls Inc. Clubs in schools. Now, girls who can't get to our center can still benefit from Girls Inc.

SUMMER CAMPS & AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMMING

In 2018 we created a new summer camp for high school girls and laid the groundwork for three new camps in 2019.

EMPOWERMENT CENTER

Through a partnership with the Birmingham housing authority, we now have a center in the Mark's Village public housing community.

IN HER CORNER

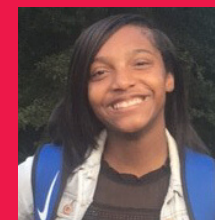
One in 6 girls will not graduate high school. Annissa is not one of them.
