Fighting for Justice

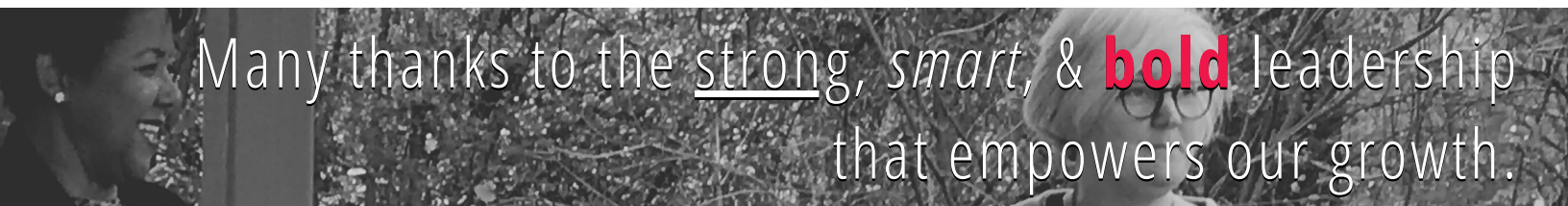
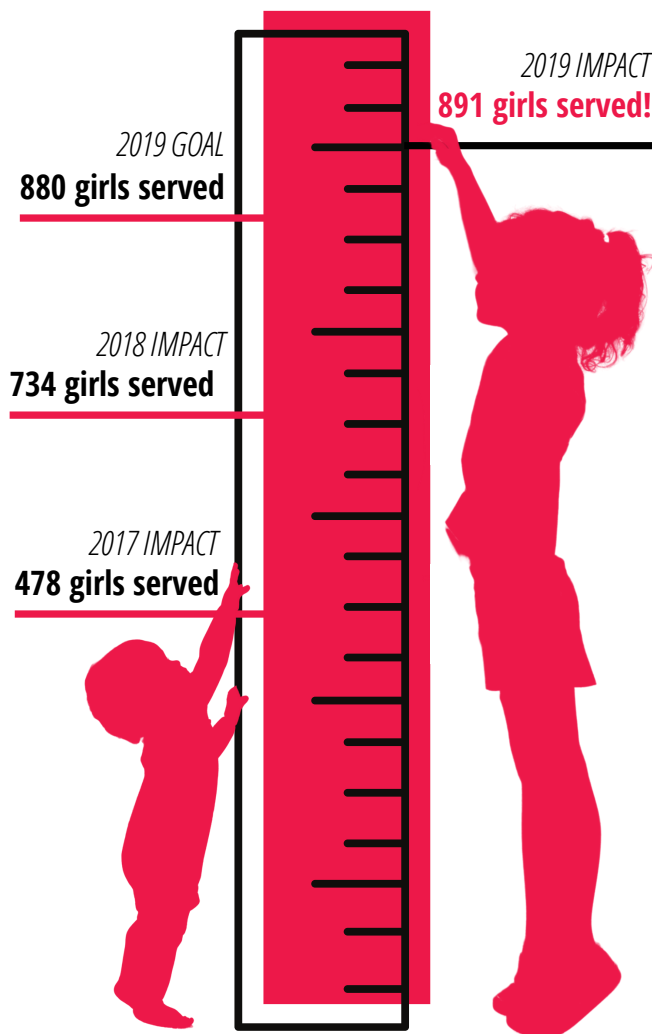
At our Crestwood Center, girls learned about gender & racial equity from leaders in our Young Women's Advocacy Council.

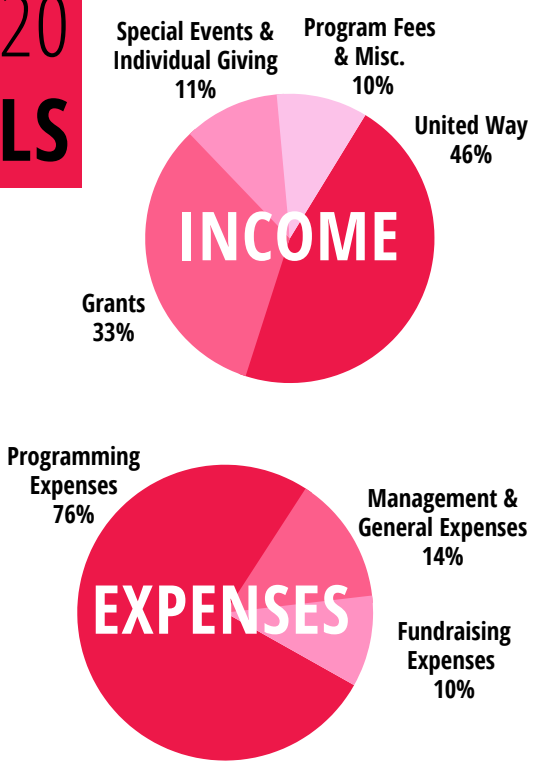
